Recently one of our school leadership teams has been having discussions around having difficult conversations. It made me think about how hard it can be to have those difficult conversations. Our students are exposed to much more than we can imagine... from peers, television, through technology, etc. I read an article from <u>ahaparenting.com</u> that gave some advice when starting these conversations. Furthermore, the question is, how can you master the art of tough conversations? They recommend these following steps;

- 1. Don't take it personally
- 2. Manage your own feelings and behavior
- 3. Always start the conversation by acknowledging your child's position
- 4. Extend respect
- 5. Reconnect with your love and empathy for your child
- 6. Keep the conversations safe for everyone
- 7. Try hard to avoid making your child defensive
- 8. Summon your sense of humor
- 9. Remember that expressing anger just makes you more angry
- 10. Hold the intention that working through a conflict in a way that meets everyone's needs can actually bring you closer to your child.





Health Coverage Options

Medi-Cal:

- Children, foster youth, pregnant women, adults, US citizens, and immigrants—including those with DACA status—may be eligible for no- or low-cost Medi-Cal.
- Medi-Cal covers immunizations, checkups, specialists, vision and dental services, and more for children and youth at no- or low-cost.
- Medi-Cal enrollment is available year-round.

Covered California:

- Covered California is where legal residents of California can compare quality health plans and choose the one that works best for them.
- Based on income and family size, many Californians may gualify for financial assistance.
- Enroll during Open Enrollment or any time you experience a life-changing event, like losing your job or having a baby. You have 60 days from the event to complete enrollment.

Undocumented Families visit: www.allinforhealth.org/undocumented Immigration status information is kept private, protected, and secure. It will not be used by any immigration agency to enforce immigration laws, but only to determine eligibility for health programs.


