Intra-District Open Enrollment for 2017-2018 School Year

Parents/guardians who would like to request a transfer for their children to attend one of our schools, rather than their assigned or current school, may do so between May 1 and May 16, 2017. Intra-district request forms are available at all four school sites and the Jefferson School District office. Please return your completed form to any school site or the district office **between May 1 and May 16**.

Intra-district requests will be considered only if there is space available at a particular site and grade level. Throughout the spring, enrollment and grade level numbers at each site will be closely monitored. Families will be notified of the decision the first week of June.
